Last year marked two firsts for the Classical Conversations Foundation: first-ever Classical Conversations National Conference and the launch of the Homeschool Families on Missions program. Generous support from homeschool families and partners allowed us to conduct these important programs.

Classical Conversations National Conference

More than three hundred adults and students attended the first-ever national conference held at the Classical Conversations headquarters in Southern Pines, North Carolina.

The national conference provided attendees with practical tools and knowledge as well as encouragement for their journey of successful Christian homeschooling.

Homeschool Families on Missions

The Homeschool Families on Missions program was also a great success that provided mission trip grants to thirty homeschool students and seven parents. Students participated on missions in locations across the United States and in seven other international locations, including Albania, Dominican Republic, Honduras, Jordan, Kyrgyzstan, Northern Ireland, and Zambia.
